THE JOY OF CHRISTMAS

"Joy is the true gift of Christmas, not expensive presents that demand time and money. We can transmit this joy simply: with a smile, with a kind gesture, with some small help, with forgiveness. Let us give this joy and the joy given will be returned to us. Let us seek in particular to communicate the deepest joy, that of knowing God in Christ. Let us pray that this presence of God's liberating joy will shine out in our lives." (Emeritus Pope Benedict XVI). The angel announced the source of Christmas joy to the shepherds on the first Christmas night: "Do not be afraid; for behold, I bring you good news of great joy which shall be for all the people; for today in the city of David there has been born for you a Saviour, who is Christ the Lord" (Luke 2:10-11).

The real joy of Christmas consists in accepting the gift from God: the gift of Jesus as our Saviour. Jesus Christ is the Saviour who was born in history, the living God in human flesh. If God has so acted in history, then it is really good news.

The true joy of Christmas lasts not only in the season of Christmas but all through our life. It is an abiding joy and contentment that comes from knowing that we have a hope that holds beyond the uncertainties of this life. That kind of lasting joy comes only to the one who has personally accepted God's gift: Jesus Christ.

Jesus is the only source that can produce lasting joy in our lives. Joy is found by looking at its letters J.O.Y : Jesus Offers You the gift of eternal life which therefore brings joy to our hearts and lives. Our part is to accept His gift and then give Him a gift back which is our life. This is the great gift exchange program of John 3.16: "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life."

We find the real joy of Christmas when we make Jesus as the focus of our life: Born in a stable, cradled in a manger, He came forth from heaven to live on earth as a mortal man and to establish the kingdom of God. His glorious gospel reshaped the thinking of the world. He lived for us, and He died for us. What can we, in return, give Him?

Our celebration of Christmas should be a reflection of the love and selflessness taught by the Saviour; Giving, not getting, brings to full bloom the Christmas spirit. When we are kind to one another, forgive one another and reach out in love to help those less fortunate, Christmas becomes alive in us. The spirit of Christmas is the Spirit of Christ and his Gospel message. When we live him - as St. Francis de Sales tells us: LIVE JESUS - in our daily life, the birth of Christ become a meaningful reality in our lives.

As the Christmas season envelops us with all its glory, may we, as did the Wise Men, seek the bright star to guide us in our celebration of the Saviour's birth. May we all make the journey to Bethlehem in spirit, taking with us a tender, caring heart as our gift to Jesus.

PMP SEMINAR

The First Parish Mission Preaching (PMP) Seminar was conducted by Rev. Fr. Agnelo Fernandes MSFS on 26 & 27 of November 2019 at Lumen Christi Institute. The seminar focused on the origin of parish missions as the foundational apostolate of the Congregation and as practiced by our Venerable Founder Father Peter Mermier. The seminar made a thorough study of PMP Manual. The group discussions highlighted the practical ways to implement PMP in East Africa. It was felt that PMP would be a great help in renewing the families in the parishes. We thank Rev. Fr. Agnelo Fernandes for guiding us to understand the primordial apostolate of the Congregation.

STEWARDSHIP FORUM MEETING & BUDGET

Stewardship Forum meeting was held on November 28, 2019 at Lumen Christi Institute. During the meeting, budgets of every community/institution was presented and evaluated. The members were reminded of following the FAST format for accounting. The meeting also discussed at length taxation and various payments to the Government. The Forum evaluated the new health insurance policy. It was felt that since the premium has gone very high, only those who use medicine regularly will join the programme. It highly recommended making a Corpus Fund which can be used in case of emergency. It also appreciated the internal auditing which began this year. The Forum felt that when a confrere is on transfer, handing over of the accounts, documents etc. has to be strictly done as per the statutes of the Province.

MEETING FOR EDUCATORS

A meeting of School managers and religious collaborators of the Province was held on 10th and 11th of December, 2019. Mr. Christian Bwaya, a lecturer of Mwenge University conducted a seminar on Child Protection and Safeguarding. The seminar focused on child centred education which would give children a safe environment for learning and nurturing their childhood. The second day's seminar was animated by Rev. Fr. Agnelo Fernandes MSFS on the theme: Fransalian Profile of an Educator. The seminar was based on Salesian Spirituality and Fransalian core identity in the education apostolate. We thank Mr. Bwaya and Rev. Fr. Fernandes for their insights to improve the quality of education in our schools.
