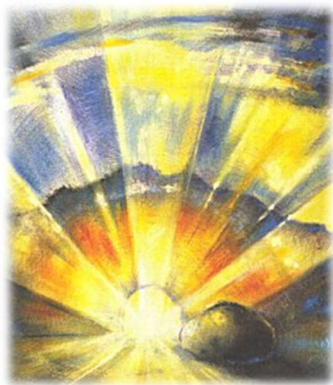
JESUS IS ALIVE

After 40 days of spiritual and physical journey of penance and self-denial, we celebrate the resurrection of Christ today. We have no doubt that Jesus is risen. His grave is not a destination but a process. Neither the cross nor the grave is an end but a means to glory. The resurrection proclaims that Jesus Christ is alive.

The Apostles and early Christians wanted to share with the world only one message and that was 'Jesus is alive'. All the accounts related to the empty tomb and various personal experiences of the risen Lord say that Jesus is risen and is alive. Each disciple had his/her own story about Jesus being alive. Even if a person wasn't at the empty tomb, even if one was not present in the upper room, one can experience the resurrected Jesus. We need only to remember the example of St. Paul who met the risen Jesus months after his death. His experience changed his whole life. Yes, the message of Easter is that Jesus is alive, and we can meet him.



On this Easter Sunday, we have to ponder where we can meet this Jesus who is alive? Is he alive in us? Do we feel his presence daily in us? Has his spirit moved our lives? If we were to spare a moment and ask ourselves to share our experiences of Jesus, what would we say? Jesus can change our lives today. The risen Lord is alive in us when we work for the advancement of the values of his Kingdom such as love, peace, truth and justice. The Lord is alive in us when we live in solidarity with our brothers and sisters, especially the poor and the needy. He is alive in us when we become agents of forgiveness and reconciliation. The risen Lord is alive in us when the flame of faith is active in us and when we share it with others. If Easter becomes just another holiday without any effect on us, then, we are not living Jesus in our personal life.



The dictum that guided our Patron St. Francis de Sales was LIVE JESUS. Let this dictum resound in our hearts and minds that we may LIVE JESUS daily in our personal life and ministry! May we learn to ask for God's grace each day so that we may live Easter everyday of our life! Then the words we say and the actions we do will proclaim to everyone we meet the truth we celebrate today: Jesus is risen! He is alive in us!

I wish all of you the blessings of the RISEN LORD who is and will be with us till the end of the world. HAPPY EASTER!.

YEAR OF ST. FRANCIS DE SALES

We are celebrating this year the 400th death anniversary of our Patron, St. Francis de Sales. To mark this occasion, our Superior General has declared an "Year of St. Francis de Sales" from April 24, 2022, (Divine Mercy Sunday) to April 16, 2023 (Divine Mercy Sunday).

In order to celebrate meaningfully the life of our beloved Patron and spiritual master, the following programmes will be organized:

1. Pope Francis has agreed to write a letter on SFS to mark the 400 death anniversary of our patron.
2. Wednesdays with St. Francis de Sales: every Wednesday from April 27, nearly 13 Congregations and lay associates are participating in a 5-minute reflection on the spirituality of SFS.
3. Celebrations in Annecy (organized by Franco-Swiss Province) with all the confreres from all over Europe.
4. A short documentary on SFS and a special calendar for 2023.
5. Starting the formation programme for Fransalian Associates in all the Provinces in view of their consecration on January 2024.
6. On December 28, 2022, (actual date of death of SFS) something to be done at the congregational level to reach out to the people in need of support.

I kindly request all our communities to begin the Year of St. Francis de Sales with a Holy Mass and Salesian Reflections on April 25, 2022. Please say the Prayer of St. Francis de Sales daily in our communities.

PARISH DAY AND BLESSING OF THE PRESBYTERY AT KALAMIRA



19th March 2022 was a historical day for St. Francis de Sales Parish at Kalamira in the Diocese of Jinja, Uganda. It was a day of blessing for all the people of God in the parish and in the whole diocese at large as our dear bishop Rev. Dr. Charles Martin Wamika made his first pastoral visit to our parish. The Holy Mass began at 10:30 am officiated by the bishop. He was accompanied by Fr. Paul Wandera, the pastoral coordinator of

the Diocese of Jinja, Fr. Godfrey, the Bursar of the Diocese, Fr. Kizito, Land and Education coordinator of the Diocese, Bishop's councillors, diocesan priests, many Religious priests and sisters. The provincial councillors of different apostolates were present along with a number of Fransalians from Tanzania and Uganda. The political leaders were represented by Hon. Akamba the MP, Mrs. Maria Women's rep (MP) and other administrative officers from the Namutumba District together with the Councillors of the Busoga kingdom. Many parishioners and many faithful from other parishes also attended the event.

During the Mass the Bishop consecrated the new tabernacle in the church, administered the sacrament of Confirmation to 168 candidates and welcomed the SMI sisters officially to work in the parish. This year being the year of the Holy Spirit in the Diocese, the Bishop blessed the cross and gave a special blessing to the parishioners and more specially to those who had different intentions. In his homily the Bishop thanked the Provincial Superior and the entire family of Fransalians for taking up the mission in Kalamira in the Diocese of Jinja.



He officially installed Fr. Sunny Thomas Vettickal msfs as the Parish Priest and Fr. Dennis Dindi msfs as the assistant Parish priest of the parish. The Bishop also blessed the newly built presbytery in Kalamira Parish and the convent building for Sisters at Namutumba. After the Mass the children from different schools entertained the assembly with various programmes. The celebrationss concluded with a sumptuous family meal.
